DOWNTOWN BROCKVILLE BIA TALLSHIPS FESTIVAL SWEEPSTAKES

OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES

CONTEST PERIOD:

The Tall Ships Festival Sweepstakes Contest (the "Contest") begins on June 24, 2022, at 1:00 PM Eastern Time and ends on June 26, 2022, at 5:00 PM Eastern Time (the "Contest Period").

AGREEMENT TO BE LEGALLY BOUND BY THESE RULES:

By participating in this Contest, you are signifying your agreement that you have read and agree to be legally bound by these Official Contest Rules (the "Rules").

ELIGIBILITY, METHOD 1:

The method of entry 1 ("Method 1") is only open to residents of Ontario who: (a) have reached the legal age of majority in their province/territory of residence at the time of entry; or (b) have not reached the legal age of majority in their province/territory of residence (a "Method 1 Minor"), and whose parent/legal guardian has agreed on his/her own behalf and on such Method 1 Minor's behalf, that each of them will be bound by these Official Contest Rules; except employees, representatives or agents (and those with whom such persons are living, whether related or not) of Downtown Brockville BIA (the "Sponsor"), its parent companies, subsidiaries, affiliates, prize suppliers, advertising/promotion agencies and any other individual or entity involved in the development, production, administration, or fulfillment of the Contest (collectively, the "Contest Parties").

HOW TO ENTER, METHOD 1:

No purchase necessary. To enter the Contest via Method 1, visit the Downtown Brockville BIA booth (Festival Entrance) when festival grounds are open & present your Tall Ships Brochure to receive an entry ballot.

To be eligible, your Method 1 Entry must be submitted and received in accordance with these Rules during the Contest Period.

Obtain and fully complete the Official Method 1 Entry Form (the "Method 1 Entry Form"). You must fully complete the Method 1 Entry Form with all required information and insert into the ballot box located at the Downtown Brockville BIA booth from Friday, June 24 at 1:00 pm until Sunday, June 26 at 5:00 pm.

ENTRY LIMIT, METHOD 1:

If it is discovered by the Sponsor (using any evidence or other information made available to or otherwise discovered by the Sponsor) that any person has attempted to: (i) exceed any of the limits stated in these Rules; and/or (ii) use multiple names, identities, email addresses and/or any automated, macro, script, robotic or other system(s) or program(s) to enter or otherwise participate in or to disrupt this Contest; then he/she may be disqualified from the Contest in the sole and absolute discretion of the Sponsor. An Entry may be rejected if (in the sole and absolute discretion of the Sponsor): (i) the Entry is not submitted and received in accordance with these Rules during the Contest Period; and/or (ii) the Entry is not otherwise in compliance with these Rules (all as determined by Sponsor in its sole and absolute discretion). The Released Parties (defined below) are not responsible for late, lost, misdirected, delayed, incomplete or incompatible Method 1 Entries or any other Contest-related information (all of which are void).

HOW TO ENTER, METHOD 2:

Make a purchase at a participating Downtown Brockville business and show a Tall Ships Passport or bracelet to receive an additional ballot.

To be eligible, your Method 2 Entry must be submitted and received in accordance with these Rules during the Contest Period.

Obtain and fully complete the Official Method 2 Entry Form (the "Method 1 Entry Form"). You must fully complete the Method 2 Entry Form with all required information and insert into the ballot box located at the Downtown Brockville BIA booth from Friday, June 24 at 1:00 pm until Sunday, June 26 at 5:00 pm.

ENTRY LIMIT, METHOD 2:

PRIZE:

PRIZE DESCRIPTION

There will be 1 prize (the "Prize"). The Prize consists of:

One Customizable Dirty Berty Paddle Board with a total approximate retail prize value of \$3,000.00CAD. The characteristics and features of the merchandise will be determined in collaboration with the prize donor (Dirty Berty Boards). The winner will communicate directly with the prize donor on all details about board design, production, and prize availability date. Delivery is not included. The winner is responsible for any costs to transport the customized paddle board from Brockville, ON. The merchandise must be accepted as awarded and is not transferable, assignable, or convertible to cash (except as may be specifically permitted by Sponsor in its sole and absolute discretion). No substitutions except at Sponsor's option. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to substitute this prizing or a component thereof with a prize of equal or greater retail value, including, without limitation, but at Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion, a cash award.

PRIZE WINNER SELECTION PROCESS:

On June 26, 2022 (the "Selection Date") in Brockville, ON at 5:00 PM Eastern Time, one (1) eligible entrant will be selected by random draw from among all eligible Entries submitted and received in accordance with these Rules during the Contest Period and such selected entrant will be deemed the potential Prize winner.

The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible Entries submitted and received in accordance with these Rules during the Contest Period.

WINNER NOTIFICATION PROCESS:

The Sponsor or its designated representative will make a minimum of 5 attempts to contact the potential Prize winner (using the information provided at the time of entry) within 10 business days of the Selection Date. If the potential Prize winner cannot be contacted within 10 business days of the Selection Date, or if there is a return of any notification as undeliverable; then he/she may, in the sole and absolute discretion of the Sponsor, be disqualified (and, if disqualified, will forfeit all rights to the applicable Prize) and the Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion and time permitting, to select an alternate potential Prize winner following the same applicable winner selection procedure described above (with the necessary amendments), in which case the foregoing provisions of this section shall apply to such new potential Prize winner.
